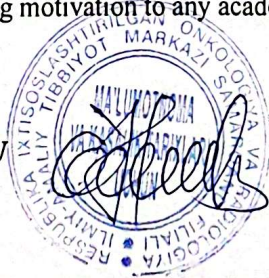

This included maintaining simple notebooks for two to three patients, where she noted their scheduled medications after they were administered by the nursing staff. This system helped patients understand their own care plans, reduced confusion, and allowed our team to spot when someone felt uncertain or anxious about their treatment. Her role was observational and organizational, but it made a meaningful difference for patients who appreciated the extra clarity and reassurance. Her interest in healthcare began with familiarity with our hospital through her family, and she chose to volunteer with us to gain genuine experience. She approached every task with respect and thoughtfulness. She was consistently careful about confidentiality and always asked appropriate questions when she was unsure. Alongside her volunteer duties, she took initiative to learn more about the conditions commonly seen in our unit. She independently researched palliative-care related diagnoses and wrote short summaries and reflections to deepen her understanding. This self-directed effort showed discipline and motivation uncommon in students her age. Our staff valued her reliability, kindness, and calm presence with patients. She remained composed even during emotionally difficult moments and demonstrated growing maturity in how she communicated with both families and clinical staff.

I believe she has the compassion, resilience, and developing intellectual curiosity to succeed in higher education and future medical training. She has shown a sincere commitment to learning and a genuine desire to support others. I recommend her confidently to your institution. She will bring dedication, empathy, and strong motivation to any academic program.
